Appointed Chief Financial Officer in 2019, George is responsible for overseeing the company's Finance teams as well as Investor Relations, Sourcing, and Corporate Strategy teams. During his time at Norfolk Southern, he has enhanced the company's focus on productivity and cost control – utilizing his expertise across multiple industrial segments to drive even greater financial success.

George has more than 30 years of experience in financial management, strategy, and business development. Before Norfolk Southern, he held successive roles of responsibility across multiple commercial and business segments of United Technologies Corporation and its subsidiaries, including six years in Asia as the regional CFO for the Otis Elevator Company.
